## **Dev Day 2024 report**

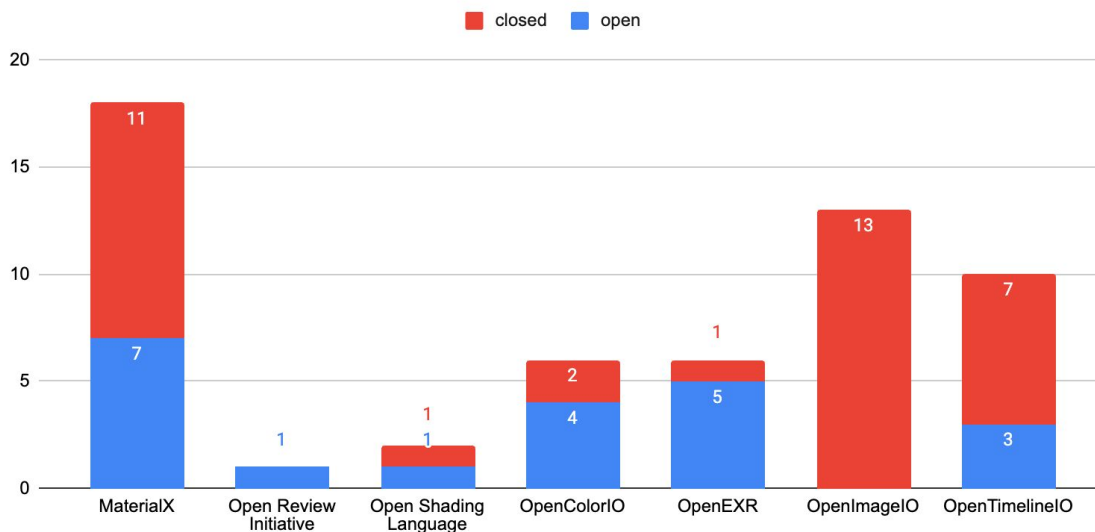
# Goals for 2024 Dev Days
